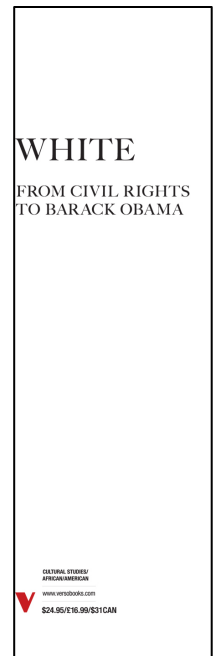
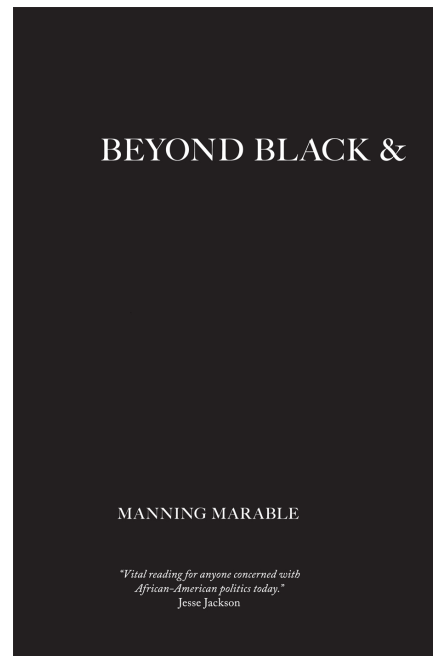

- Upon its first publication in 1995, *Beyond Black and White* was widely acclaimed as being of central importance to African-American Studies both in the United States and worldwide.
- In this new expanded edition, Manning Marable brings his seminal study up-to-date with a new preface examining the developments in African-American politics of the last decade. He takes account of continued change in ethnic demographics and calls for a social protest movement based on a radical reimagining of the American city.
