Position Description: The University of Missouri – Kansas City, invites applications for a tenured associate professor to serve as a core faculty person in the Black Studies Program. The successful candidate will have a broad-based knowledge of the field as indicated by training, scholarly record, and research agenda. Interested persons should be able to teach two or more of the core courses in Black studies and be qualified to teach and conduct research in one or more of the following areas: African American expressive culture, including forms, traditions, and factors impacting cultural production; Black politics, elite structures, and power in American society; African American social and cultural movements; African American community life, including but not limited to comparative religious expression, philosophical orientations, family entrepreneurial activity, media traditions, and health beliefs and behavior. The ability to integrate womanist content and perspectives into the Black Studies curriculum is a plus.

Qualifications: A Ph.D. in African American studies or related discipline and a research and publication record sufficient for tenure at the associate professor level are required.

Special Application Instructions: Applicants must submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statement of teaching philosophy, teaching evaluations, and representative publications.

Other Information: Shortlisted candidates will be required to submit three current professional letters of reference.
